



NAAP Conference 2004 Vendor Contract

THIS AGREEMENT, made this ____ day of August/September 2004, by and between _____ of _____ (Vendor) and _____ of the Conference Committee (Organizer) of NAAP to be held at the Hyatt Harborside Hotel, Boston MA on September 26-27, 2004 (Conference).

WITNESSETH, that the Vendor and the Organizer, for the consideration of \$_____ paid in advance, agree as follows:

- I. The Organizer shall provide general marketing of the Conference to the community, making no guarantees as to the number of participants in the Conference or any specific marketing efforts.
- II. The Organizer shall provide a table for the Vendor, from which the Vendor may advertise and/or sell the Vendor’s product(s) during the Conference.
- III. The Vendor shall be solely responsible for the state of said table and product(s) prior to, during, and after the Conference.
- IV. The Vendor shall be solely responsible for the set-up and clean-up of said table and all product(s) for the duration of the Conference, and shall be solely responsible for any charges assessed by Hotel for the clean-up of said table and immediate area thereof, as necessary, after the Conference.
- V. The Vendor understands that the Organizer shall not provide any security measures or services to the Vendor prior to, during, or after the Conference.
- VI. The Vendor understands that the Organizer shall not provide any insurance for product(s) or person(s) at the Conference.
- VII. The Vendor understands that the Organizer shall provide the booth space on an “as-is” basis.
- VIII. The Vendor understands that the Organizer is not a legal entity, but rather a group of individuals providing their volunteer services to the Vendor and other vendors for the purpose of facilitating the marketing and sale of said vendors’ product(s) to community members during the Conference.
- IX. The Vendor understands that the Organizer shall not provide a full or partial refund under any circumstances whatsoever.

The undersigned jointly and severally hereby forever release, discharge, acquit and forgive from any and all claims, actions, suits, demands, agreements, liabilities, judgments, and proceedings both at law and in equity arising from the beginning of time to the date of these presents and as more particularly related to or arriving from the Conference.

This release shall be binding upon and inure to the benefit of the parties, their successors, assigns and personal representatives. This is the entire agreement.
